

**HOLY NAME HIGH SCHOOL**  
**EUGENE T. KRAKOWIAK SCHOLARSHIP**

**Background:**

From 1968 until 1996, Eugene T. Krakowiak served as the principal of Holy Name High School. During his tenure, he inspired the faculty, staff, and students of Holy Name to work hard, value others, and most importantly, to live their faith. The Eugene T. Krakowiak Scholarship was established in his honor, with the ETK Golf Classic held each year to ensure these grants can be awarded annually. Although “Mr. K” passed away in 2012, his legacy lives on in those whose lives he impacted, and hopefully will continue to do so in the future Namers who will benefit from this scholarship.

**Four (4) \$1,000 renewable scholarships (4 years) will be awarded to four 8<sup>th</sup> grade students who are currently attending Catholic grade schools.** This scholarship will be awarded to each recipient for their four years at Holy Name High School providing the student remains in acceptable academic and disciplinary standing as determined by the selection committee.

**Applicant Criteria:**

- The applicant must be a current 8<sup>th</sup> grader attending a Catholic grade school who is interested in attending Holy Name High School next year.
- The applicant must demonstrate solid character and be working to his or her academic ability as attested to by the signature on the application of their grade school principal.
- The applicant should demonstrate some type of extra-curricular participation through service, athletics, campus ministry, student government, etc.

**Application Process**

The applicant is required to complete the application on the back of this page either typed or printed along with a typed essay (double spaced, 12 font, Times New Roman, no more than 2 pages) addressing the following question: **How do you see yourself embodying the “triple threat” of “Mind- Body-Spirit” over the next four years while a student at Holy Name High School?**

The applicant must include a copy of their 7<sup>th</sup> and current 8<sup>th</sup> grade report cards.

**The completed scholarship application along with your essay must be returned to the Holy Name High School Admissions Office, 6000 Queens Highway, Parma Heights, Ohio 44130 by Tuesday, December 19, 2017.**
