Background:

The Joseph Franck '73 Memorial Scholarship was established in 2012 by his immediate family members. Joe's daughters, Jessica (class of 2000) and Caroline (class of 2003), along with son, Michael, felt their dad's strong ties to his friends and family through his connection with his alma mater. Joe graduated from the class of 1973 and went on to establish a successful CPA business largely due to his support from fellow Namers. Joe loved his camaraderie with fellow Holy Name alumni and will always stay connected through this scholarship.

One (1) \$1,000 non-renewable scholarship will be awarded at the class awards assembly held in May. This grant will be used for the following academic year. Scholarship awards may be increased, reduced, or terminated by the Scholarship Fund Committee if the need should arise.

Applicant Criteria:

- The applicant must be currently enrolled as a sophomore at Holy Name High School
- The applicant must be of solid character and in good academic standing with a grade point average of 3.0 or higher
- The applicant must have made a substantial service to Holy Name and/or the community by being involved in an athletic organization or extracurricular activity
- The applicant must have good attendance through his or her freshman and sophomore years
- Math grades or math electives could be used as a tie breaker

Selection Committee:

- Two (2) representatives from the Franck family
- The principal or assistant principal of Holy Name High School
- The current director of constituent relations
- A graduate from the class of 1973
- A current sophomore faculty member of Holy Name High School or class officer

Application Process:

The student will be required to complete the application on the back of this page, providing the following information either printed or typed:

- Name, address, grade, homeroom, and grade point average
- Service record/school related activities
- School, parish, and community service project involvement
- Attendance record
- Applicant's signature and a parent/guardian's signature

*The application is to be accompanied by an essay of 50-100 words on the topic:
"What Holy Name High School Means to You".*

Friday, March 23, 2018. Applications that do not include an essay
will not be considered. Please paperclip the required essay to the application;
do not staple.**
