RICHARD KOENIG MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Background:

Established in 2016, the Richard Koenig Memorial Scholarship was created to honor the memory of Rick Koenig, who passed away in 2015. Rick was a loving husband to his wife, Deidre (Dee Dee) Maloney '81 Koenig, and a devoted father to his three children, Ricky '05, Ryan '10 and Rachael '14. He loved watching and cheering on his children and their teammates as they competed in wrestling, football and volleyball for the Green Wave. Rick and Dee Dee also were very involved in their parish community, St. Ambrose in Brunswick. He epitomized what it means to be a 'family man,' and will forever be remembered for the love and respect he had for all those who were lucky to call him a friend.

Each year, one (1) \$750 non-renewable scholarship will be awarded to an eighth grader entering Holy Name High School. The scholarship award may be increased, decreased, or terminated by the Richard Koenig Memorial Scholarship Committee if the need should arise.

Applicant Criteria:

- The applicant must be a current eighth grader who will be entering Holy Name High School this upcoming fall
- The applicant must be involved in their current school community, and be well-rounded in extra-curricular activities
- The applicant must complete the required essay prompt, which is 'Why did you choose Holy Name?'

Selection Committee:

- Representatives from the Koenig Family

Application Process:

The student will be required to complete the application on the back of this page, providing the following information either printed or typed:

- Name, address, email, grade school, and approximate grade average
- School, parish, and/or community-related extra-curricular activities
- Applicant's signature and a parent/guardian's signature

The application must be accompanied by an essay of up to 500 words that considers the following question:

Why did you choose Holy Name?

The completed scholarship application must be returned to the Holy Name Advancement Office by Friday, March 23, 2018.

Applications that do not include an essay will not be considered. Please paperclip the required essay to the application; do not staple.
