Background:

The Sisters of Charity Scholarship was established in 2002, in memory of Sister Marie Magdalen Dunn, educator and assistant principal of Holy Name High School from 1970 to 1996. The purpose of this fund is to enable qualified students to receive a Catholic education at Holy Name High School.

Award amounts will vary from year to year and will be awarded at the class awards assembly held in May. All grants will be used for the following academic year.

Applicant Criteria:

- The applicant must have completed his/her freshman year at Holy Name High School and be currently enrolled as a sophomore
- The applicant must be of solid character and maintain a grade point average of 3.0
- The applicant must prove that he/she has been an active member of Holy Name or the community by regular participation in academic/service activities
- The applicant must demonstrate evidence of financial need

Application Process:

The student will be required to complete the application on the back of this page, providing:

- Name, address, grade, homeroom, age, and grade point average
- School, parish, and/or community project involvement of applicant and parent(s)
- Circumstances or condition of the household that would qualify as a financial need
- Applicant's signature and a parent/guardian's signature

The application is to be accompanied by a 500-word essay on the following topic:
Catholic Education – Making a Difference in Today's World

The completed scholarship application should be returned to the Holy Name Advancement Office by Friday, March 23, 2018. Applications that do not include an essay will not be considered. Please paperclip the required essay to the application; do not staple.
