

CIOLEK EDUCATIONAL FUND

Background:

The purpose of the Ciolek Educational Fund is to provide family members of the Donors (and certain other grantees) with funds to obtain an education at Holy Name High School, St. Mary's Prep School in Orchard Lake, Michigan, or any approved Catholic high school in the State of Ohio.

The maximum award to a Grantee for any calendar year shall be equally divided among Grantees as decided by Committee. Subject to the maximum yearly award limitation, in the event that scholarships from the Fund are awarded to more than one Family Member Grantee during a calendar year, the amount available to fund such scholarships shall be evenly divided among the Family Members. Subject to the maximum yearly award limitation, awards to Non-Family Member Grantee shall be in such amounts as determined by the Committee.

Applicant Criteria:

Scholarship awards under the fund shall be made effective each August. Such awards shall be made first to any family member of the Donors approved by the Committee (the "Family Members"); provided, however, if no Family Members exist or apply for such scholarship awards for such year, such awards may be made to any other student(s) of the School as determined by the Committee in its discretion. The recipients of such scholarships shall be referred to herein as the "Grantees."

Family Members shall apply for a scholarship from the Fund by submitting an application to the Principal of the School, indicating their relationship to the Donors and the name of the Catholic high school that they will be attending. Non-Family Members shall apply for a scholarship from the Fund by submitting an application to the Principal of the School. The application will be reviewed and approved by the Committee.

A non-family member applicant must be:

- Currently enrolled as a freshman, sophomore, or junior at Holy Name High School
- Demonstrate good character
- Have made a substantial service contribution to the school
- Be working to the best of his or her academic ability

Application Process:

The student will be required to complete the application on the back of this page, providing the following information either printed or typed:

- Name, address, school name (Holy Name High School), grade, and grade point average
- Relationship to Father Ciolek (if any)
- School-related activities
- Applicant's signature and a parent/guardian's signature

The completed scholarship application should be returned to the Holy Name Advancement Office by Thursday, March 21, 2019.
