

HOLY NAME HIGH SCHOOL
FRANK DiMARINO MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Background:

Established in 2012 by his family, friends, and the Holy Name community, the Frank DiMarino Memorial Scholarship was created to honor a student, and his or her family, for their commitment to community service.

A graduate of St. Joseph High School, Frank became a part of the Holy Name community when his four children Mike ('02), Tracy ('05), Joe ('07), and Danny ('11) were students.

Frank served as the HN Booster Club treasurer for eight years and was a dedicated fan of Holy Name athletics. In 2010, Frank and his wife, Debbie, were inducted into the Holy Name High School Hall of Fame as recipients of the Arata Award, which recognizes non-graduates who have been an integral part of the school. Frank will be remembered for his dedication to his family, his contagious smile, and his years of service to Holy Name.

Two (2) \$1,000 non-renewable scholarships will be awarded at the class awards assembly held in May. This grant will be used for the following academic year.

Applicant Criteria:

- The applicant must be currently enrolled as a freshman, sophomore, or junior at Holy Name High School
- The applicant must be of solid character and in good academic standing
- The applicant and his or her parents must have made substantial service contributions to Holy Name and/or outside organizations

Selection Committee:

- Representatives from the DiMarino family
- The principal of Holy Name High School
- Two (2) current faculty members of Holy Name High School as chosen by the DiMarino family and the administration of Holy Name High School

Application Process:

The student will be required to complete the application on the back of this page, providing the following information either printed or typed:

- Name, address, grade, homeroom, age, and grade point average
- School, parish and/or community project involvement of applicant and parent(s)
- Applicant's signature and a parent/guardian's signature

The application is to be accompanied by an essay of 500 words or less, answering the following question:

"How has your family played an integral part in your desire to give back to your school and/or community?"

The completed scholarship application should be returned to the Holy Name Advancement Office by Thursday, March 21, 2019. Applications that do not include an essay will not be considered. Please paperclip the required essay to the application; do not staple.
