

## HOLY NAME HIGH SCHOOL

### BRYAN '53 AND BETH GALLAGHER '52 POWERS SCHOLARSHIP

#### Background:

Established in 2019 by the family of Bryan '53 and Beth Gallagher '52 Powers, this scholarship was created to honor a student for his/her commitment to the ideals of Holy Name High School.

Bryan and Beth are graduates of Holy Name, as are many of their relatives, including their seven children and several grandchildren. They are dedicated Namers and have served the school in many capacities. Bryan is a member of the Athletic Hall of Fame and they are both recipients of the Fred and Ruth Seitz Award, which recognizes a married couple for their service to the school. As the manager of the school cafeteria from 1977 to 1988, Beth's kind nature endeared her to faculty and students alike. They continue to attend and support numerous events at the school.

Two (2) \$1,000 non-renewable scholarships will be awarded at the class awards assembly held in May. This grant will be used for the following academic year.

#### Applicant Criteria:

- The applicant must be currently enrolled as a freshman, sophomore or junior at Holy Name High School
- The applicant must be of solid character and in good academic standing
- The applicant must submit an essay of 250-500 words

#### Selection Committee:

- Representatives from the Powers family
- The principal of Holy Name High School
- Two current faculty members of Holy Name High School as chosen by the Powers family and the administration of Holy Name High School

#### Application Process:

The student will be required to complete the application on the back of this page, providing the following information by either printing or typing:

- Name, address, grade, homeroom, and grade point average
- School, parish and/or community involvement of applicant
- Applicant's signature and the signature of a parent/guardian
- The application is to be accompanied by an essay based on the statement "remember you're a Namer"

Bryan would often remind his children as they left home for a night out to "remember you're a Powers." Their actions reflected not only on themselves but on their family. They were to respect and honor the name they carried by their words and actions. **With that thought in mind, the essay that is to accompany this application is, *what does the statement "remember you're a Namer" mean to you? As a student at Holy Name how do your words and actions reflect positively on the school? How do you bring honor to the school? What does it mean to be a Namer?***
