## JACK RICHARDSON '79 MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

In May 2017, the Holy Name High School community lost alumnus and athletic director, Jack Richardson '79. Jack began serving as the school's athletic director in 2009. Prior to his time in that position, he was already involved at his alma mater. Jack served on the Holy Name Advisory Board, and was a dedicated member of both the Alumni Association and Athletic Boosters.

Along with being the athletic director, Jack enjoyed giving back to the community he was proud to be a part of for so many years. He volunteered with Holy Name's St. Joseph of Arimathea Pallbearer Society, helped deliver Christmas gifts to Holy Name Elementary each year, and often attended and helped serve at Holy Name's monthly Chapel Mass celebration. Above all else, Jack was a devoted and proud father of his two sons, Ryan '10 and Michael '12. He also leaves behind so many who knew him as a loyal friend who was always willing to help.

The Holy Name Class of 2017 established this scholarship in Jack's memory in order to honor a student who has shown commitment to not only extracurricular activities, but to service at Holy Name as well. One (1) \$400 non-renewable scholarship will be awarded at the class awards assembly held in May. The grant will be used for the following academic year.
